

SELECTIVE SERVICE REQUIREMENT

Selective Service Requirement

In accordance with section 3345.32 of the Ohio Revised Code, all male students between the ages of 18 and 26 who are residents of Ohio, must be registered with the Selective Service System. Any student not in compliance will be contacted regarding their non-compliance status. Failure to comply may result in cancellation of any state based financial aid and incur non resident tuition fees.

Individuals may not be required to file a selective service statement for one of the following reasons:

- (i) The individual is under eighteen or over twenty-six years of age.
- (ii) The individual is on active duty with the armed forces of the United States other than for training in a reserve or national guard unit.
- (iii) The individual is a nonimmigrant alien lawfully in the United States in accordance with section 101 (a)(15) of the "Immigration and Nationality Act," 8 U.S.C. 1101, as amended.
- (iv) The individual is not a citizen of the United States and is a permanent resident of the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands or the Northern Mariana Islands.
